ARPU REVENUE REPORT Q3 FY 2017-18


Highlights:

- The Gross Revenue (GR) of COAI members was reported 32,805 Cr. Airtel reported highest 1 Gross Revenue of 14,749 Cr. GR of Airtel, Voda & Aircel declined by 1%, 8% and 11% respectively on a QoQ basis. 2 The total AGR for the COAI member TSPs in the December quarter was reported 19,015 Cr. Average Revenue per User (ARPU)* for the COAI member TSPs in the December quarter was 3 reported INR 77. In the December quarter, Vodafone reported the highest (ARPU)* of INR 90 followed by Airtel 4 with INR 84. 5 The total License Fee (LF) paid by the COAI members in the December quarter was 1,615 Cr. Airtel paid maximum **LF** of 673 Cr to the exchequer. 6 Airtel paid a maximum Spectrum Usage Charge (SUC) of 352 Cr to the exchequer in the 7 December quarter. Among the **Metro Circles**¹ in India, Mumbai reported the highest AGR in the December quarter. Delhi reported a maximum decline in AGR on QoQ & YoY basis. Mumbai reported the highest ARPU in the December guarter. Among Circle A², Tamil Nadu reported the highest AGR in the December quarter. 9 Karnataka reported the highest ARPU. Among Circle B3, U.P (E) reported the highest AGR in the December quarter while Kerala 10 reported the highest ARPU. Among Circle C4, Bihar reported the highest AGR in the December quarter while Assam reported 11 the highest ARPU. 12 At PAN India level, Tamil Nadu reported the highest AGR for December quarter. At PAN India level, Kerala reported the highest ARPU for December quarter. 13


1. Gross Revenue- Operators for December quarter






4. License Fee- December quarter 2017

Airtel paid a maximum **Spectrum Usage Charge (SUC)** of 352 crores to the exchequer in the December quarter.








9. Spectrum Usage Charge- Industry
























